("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This Trawler was built in 1915-10 to class, but in 19.3.25 the COMMITTEE approved withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.

Reclassification is now desired.

The greater part of a PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (D) for RECLASSIFICATION was held at ALLOA from 9.46 to 9.48 - see GLs. Rpt. No. 73525.

The LEITH Surveyors report (1.49), ship afloat, and the PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (D) for RECLASSIFICATION as above completed.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED this ship is worthy to be reclassified, as LOCAL "Stm.Trawler", with record of docking 5.47, and to have the Notation of "S.S. All.9.48(Dr)", with particulars as formerly, but excluding "Lloyd's A & CP".
