Dear Sir,

I was duly favoured with your letter of the 16th ultimo enclosing a report from Mr. Verne Dyer on the re-erection of the steel screw motor barge No. 1343, and beg to thank you for your attention.

I shall be glad if you will inform Mr. Dyer that it is concluded the deck house erection is efficient, although somewhat unfair, but that he should state if this is so, and also whether the inner surfaces of the bottom plating are covered by cement. ✓

Mr. Dyer should forward particulars of size, weight and test of the anchors and chain cables supplied, and I beg to point out that additional stiffening in way of the winch should be fitted to his satisfaction.

With regard to the machinery I may say that a report should be furnished on a First Entry Report Form (Rpt.4), and it should be stated whether all the requirements of the Rules have been complied with.
