M. A report has been received from the Society's Surveyors on the special survey during construction of the single screw motor barge No.1343 built to your order by Messrs.The Rennie, Ritchie & Newport S.B.Co. of Wivenhoe.

It is understood that after erection the vessel has been dismantled and shipped to Tampico for re-erection and completion, and I have to inform you that in order to obtain the Society's classification it will be necessary for the re-erection to be carried out under the inspection of a Surveyor on behalf of this Society, and reported upon for the Committee's information. At the present time the Society has no Surveyor stationed at Tampico, but if classification is desired, the Committee would be prepared to ask Lloyd's Agents at Tampico to appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to survey the vessel during re-erection, with a view to classification on completion.

I shall therefore be glad to learn if you desire that this course should be adopted, and, if so, that you will be so good as to give instructions to the Firm who may be carrying out the re-erection. Upon hearing from you that you agree to this course, I shall have pleasure in communicating with Lloyd's Agents at Tampico accordingly.
