Gentlemen,

With reference to your first entry report No. 22116 on the new steamer "CONSORT", I have to inform you that according to the particulars of the chain cable, certificate No. 36727, as supplied by the Superintendent of the Proving House, Tipton, it is found that the cable is 60 fathoms & 2 ft. by 12/16" instead of 60 fathoms by 13/16" as given in your report (for which no certificate of test had been produced), and also that only one end shackle has been supplied in place of two as required by the Rules.

I am therefore directed to state that ~~to~~ entitle the vessel to the figure 1 for equipment the chain cable must be supplied in accordance with the Rules, and that two end shackles are required for the cable as stated in the Rules.
