Gentlemen,

I have to inform you that it appears from a first entry report No. 22116 on the new steamer "CONSORT", received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull, that to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done, viz;- The top of the casing to be riveted after the machinery is fitted, and the after compartment filled with water up to the height of the load line, for the purpose of testing the bulkhead, also that the certificate of test of chain cable requires to be produced and compared with the cable.

I have therefore to request that you will be so good as to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion forward a report on Form No. 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
