With reference to your report No.4/659 of survey held on the steamer "PRINCESS ELAINE", I have to say that it is concluded the thickness of the strake below the sheerstrake at the ends is as approved and that an oil gland has been fitted, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether this is so. I shall also be glad to learn the capacity of the emergency tanks forward.
