The following alterations have now been carried out:-

Temporary gunner's accommodation in the after 'tween decks removed;

Starboard side of tonnage well:- 2 sidelights and 2 sanitary discharges removed and E.W. closing plates fitted.

Port side: 1 sidelight removed and E.W. closing plate fitted.

In after 'tween decks, 3 port and 2 starboard sidelights removed and E.W. closing plates fitted.

Tonnage well forward bulkhead port and starboard doorway entrances closed by E.W. steel plates.


