Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

The 'tween deck accommodation aft at nos 4+5 'tween deck spaces removed and the following ventilators at foreboard deck dispensed with and deck in way efficiently plated over.

2 @ 9' dia ; 1 @ 6' dia + 2 @ 8' dia (P.S) ; 1 @ 6' and 1 @ 8' dia S.S. (all cowl vents)

The side scuttles at shell serving the above spaces now removed and shell plating in way permanently blanked off.

The vessel has now been fitted with approved steel hatch covers of "The Simplex Type" at the main cargo hatchways on foreboard deck.
