Motorship "DUE GOLFI"

I have to acquaint you that the case of this ship has been reconsidered by the Committee today in conjunction with your letter of the 9th May, and they are surprised to learn that the Owners have not arranged for the Donkey Boiler Survey to be completed, bearing in mind the previous decision, conveyed to the Owners through the Naples Surveyors on the 12th March that the inspection was to be completed without fail before the end of April.

In the Committee's view the adjustment of the safety valves and the examination of the oil burning arrangements under working conditions are matters which should not cause any undue delay to the ship, and in these circumstances they must require the survey to be completed on the ship's return to an Italian port in three weeks' time.

You should impress upon the Owners that if this is not done the vessel's class will be jeopardised.
