The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 12,54 which was approved postponed until 12,55.

There is an Endorsement of Class (B).

In a letter dated 17.2.56 the Piraeus Surveyors were requested to inform the Owners that the survey must definitely be put in hand at the end of 2,56 or the Committee would have no option but to deal with the ship's class.

The PIRAEUS Surveyors report (4,56), ship examined afloat and the Special Survey commenced by the examination of the main deck and Nos. 1 & 2 holds, as a result of which repairs are recommended to shell and deck plating.

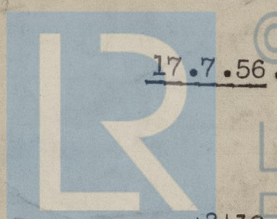
Since the Owners were not prepared to carry out the above mentioned repairs, and as she is now classed with the Hellenic Register of Shipping, the Special Survey has been cancelled.

In a covering letter <sup>dated 30/6/56</sup> forwarding the above mentioned report the Piraeus Surveyors advise that the Owners have now transferred the classification of this ship to the Greek Register.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED for consideration whether the class of this ship be expunged on account of non-compliance with the Regulations.
