We shall be much obliged to receive the Committee's favourable consideration regarding this case as soon as possible.

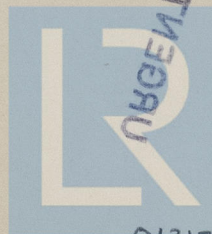
