Motorship "REDSHANK C"

I have to remind you that in January last the Ipswich Surveyors reported that the surveys for classification of this ship have been completed but that trouble had been experienced with the nylon propeller blades.

Since that time considerable correspondence has passed between this office, your good selves and the Copenhagen Surveyors regarding the fitting of acceptable propeller blades but up to the present this matter has not been finalised.

Bearing in mind the fact that the ship is now in service, it was decided to recommend the ship to the Committee for classification with a subject on the machinery to the effect that a propeller of approved material should be fitted by the end of January, 1961.

The case has been fully discussed by the Committee at their meeting today and in the light of the information now available they are not prepared to class the ship now and have deferred action for the time being. They desire the builders to be informed that the recommended class will be confirmed when a propeller acceptable to the Society has been fitted.

I shall be glad if you will advise interested parties accordingly.
