1959 and subsequently for the purpose of examining the undermentioned deep tanks.

The forward midship deep tanks P & S were pressed up with a head of water to
the level of the weather deck and upon examination the forward and after transverse
bulkheads, tank tops, hatch coamings and covers, ventilators, air and sounding
pipes and all connections found sound and tight.

The No. 6 double bottom tank in way of the above deep tanks was pressed up with
a head of water to the level of the weather deck and upon examination the tank top
and bilge well found sound and tight.

The heating coils in the above tanks were tested under steam pressure and found
sound and tight.

The above deep tanks in these respects are considered fit to receive a cargo of
vegetable oil in bulk for the contemplated voyage.
