Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to indented No. 7 plate from aft in 1st strake and No. 8 plate from aft in 2nd strake below sheerstrake (s.s) and the deep tank bulkhead being repaired at the Owners' convenience.

The 1st S.S. No. 1, due 12.41, has been partly held.

The KOBE Surveyors report the vessel afloat and the deep tanks tested under water pressure, also the double bottom tanks in way tested, prior to receiving a shipment of cargo.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as above.
