REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage stated caused by fire on the 21st December 1937 whilst vessel lay afloat at fitting out wharf.

RECOMMENDED.

Steel bulkhead & frame No. 54 slightly buckled & pierced in two places for the insertion of fire hose.

Buckled plate to be faired in place, riveted closing plates to be fitted afterwards bulkhead hose tested.

3 Beam brackets slightly buckled.

To be removed, faired & refitted.

One channel frame slightly buckled on face flange.

To be faired in place.

Aft screen bulkhead pierced near top for insertion of hose.

To have closing plate fitted.

Wood lining at fore & aft bulkheads ceiling and ship's side part burned & soaked with water.

Burned lining to be renewed and other parts removed dried and refitted.

Granulated cork insulation in cotton bags at ship's side & ceiling part burned and part saturated by water.

To be renewed.


This vessel is in good condition and eligible in my opinion to be classed as recommended in Ist Entry Report herewith.
