Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 11th instant forwarding an appeal made by the Owners of the Whaler "BALLENA", that Mr. Bevan, your Marine Surveyor, might be authorised to undertake the necessary survey for reinstatement of class of this ship in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee, however, have made a general decision that classification or reclassification surveys must always in future be carried out by exclusive Surveyors to this Society, and must decline to make any departure from that rule in this case.
