Hyde, the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Dominion Chain Company, Ltd., attend at their works at Niagara Falls, Ontario, on October 23rd., 1943, for the purpose of inspecting 1 length of 11/16" Mild Steel Steering Gear Chain, 200'-0", 3-9/32" x 2-7/16" outside dimensions, weighing 1056 lbs., to order No. 136 of Drummond McCall & Co. Ltd., Montreal, Quebec.


Breaking tests were made from the length of chain in accordance with the Rules of this Society for Close Link Steel Chain with satisfactory results. The chain was subjected to Proof test of 15600 lbs. after which each individual link was given a careful inspection and so far as could be seen, the workmanship and material were good.

Each end link, and one link in every five fathoms, were stamped: D.C. 5089 J.G.H. 23.10.45 L.R.
