Sir,

I regret to inform you that an error has been made in respect to the First Entry Fees for the survey of the machinery on the steamer "WAR APPLE", Messrs. E. Finch & Co's No.365. The Boilers having been built under British Corporation survey, the total fee for installation only should be charged viz., £14:5:6, as the fee for survey of machinery built by Messrs. McKie & Baxter has been paid to the Glasgow office, The sum of £28:11:2 has been overcharged and paid.

As the fee for boiler survey of the steamer "WAR FOREST" Messrs. E. Finch & Co's No.359 amounting to £17:4:6 (See your letter of 1st Oct., 1919) has not yet been paid, I respectfully suggest that the balance of £11:6:8 be refunded to Messrs. E. Finch & Co., in settlement of these matters.
