They have been informed that before the classification certificates can be issued, it will be necessary for all the fees to be paid, and for the Builders' authority to be obtained before they can be handed over.

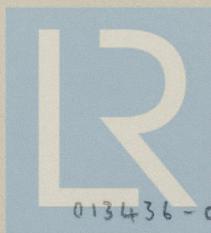
