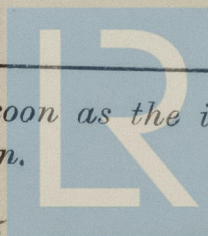
In connexion therewith Lloyds state they have been informed by Arcos Ltd. that the name should be "SELENGA"

## ANSWER.

10th. May, 1934

The name of this vessel should be SELENGA not ZELANGA, as stated in our Report No. 20259. The name was seen on the vessel and on enquiry on board for the correct spelling it was given as "ZELANGA", the letter S could have been taken as either S or Z. We have confirmed the name at the Custom House, and on all the ship's papers in their possession it is spelt "SELENGA".
