I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant relative to the steam tug-boats "GAGA", "AMAR" and "AMARER", the contents of which have been carefully noted, and with regard thereto I have to say that in these three cases the Committee have given instructions for the classes of these vessels to be omitted from the next reprint of the Society's Register Book unless the Surveyors' Surveys have been carried out in the meantime.
