The Belfast Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of the 1st S.S. No.2, due 4,33, complied with.

The bottom has been cleared and coated and repairs effected to chain locker bulkhead, rigging etc.

On account of damage through striking canal bank and fire, 4 shell plates, 5 floors, 4 frames repaired and minor repairs effected.

Turbo Electric Machinery has now been fitted and alterations to tankers etc. in accordance with approved plans.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11,33 and notation of S.S. Bel No.2-33.
