Reverting to your cablegram of the 21st and my reply of the 29th ultimo, the case of the above named ship has been brought before the Committee today.

After giving very careful consideration to the circumstances, they have come to the conclusion that they can do no other than expunge the vessel's class owing to non-compliance with the Society's Regulations, and I shall be obliged if you will inform the Owners to this effect.

This decision does not alter that conveyed to you in my cablegram, namely, that a short termsload line certificate may be issued provided a general inspection of the vessel is made afloat and all the freeboard items are surveyed and found to be satisfactory.
