I have your letter regarding the question of spare gear for the M.V. "POLSTJARNAN" ex "M.M.S. 1006", and have to state that, repeatedly raised this question before the survey was finished and was informed that the Owners were endeavouring to obtain the gear.

The vessel was sold to an Iceland Firm just before the trial and they took the vessel away the next day without advising anyone, not even the old Owners or the Ship-repairers who had a few odd items to complete.

From this you will see that no arrangements were made and from the general manner of the new Owners I doubt if they have any intention of complying with this Rule requirement.

The visit of Mr. Mathieson has been of assistance to me but unfortunately I also had to be out during the time he was here. I am still in a mess but hope before long things will even out.
