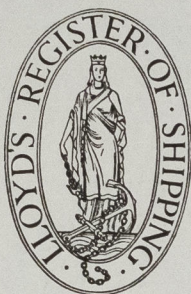

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Master attended on board the

M/T ALAN

8223 gross tons of Zadar whilst lying afloat and in drydock at Taranto on the 24 th June 1966 and subsequently for the purpose of examining the Freeboard items for the Annual Survey in the manner prescribed in the Rules annexed to the International Load Line Convention 1930.

The conditions of the items surveyed was found to be satisfactory except for the following recommendations:

- Access doors to forecastle, poop deck and pump rooms to be overhauled.
- Wire gauze of O.F. tank air pipes to be renewed.
- Freeboard marks to be checked and recut.
- Eleven deadlights on poop front and midship dechhouse to be renewed.

Repairs of above items have been satisfactorily carried out and the relevant Freeboard items considered now to be in efficient condition.
