Ltd. attend their Works on the 28th June, 1949, and subsequently, for the purpose of examining and testing 1 R.H. solid 4 bladed Bronze Propeller marked Z.9109 R.H., made to the order of Messrs. Mollers' Stores (U.K.) Ltd., and intended for Vessel No. 342. The casting was examined and found satisfactory.

Separately cast test pieces were subsequently identified and afterwards tested in my presence with the following results:-
