Dear Sir,

F. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant respecting the steamers "ALGERIA", "MASILIA" and "VALENCIA", from which I note that the Owners have now decided to retain the 1906 freeboards for these ships. In the circumstances I enclose amended computations and Swedish Certificates, in triplicate, in accordance therewith.

With reference to the third paragraph of your letter I have to inform you that your statement to the Owners' Representative that "the Society can only issue certificates in accordance with 1906 year's regulations or with the new Convention rules" is correct in so far as it applies to British ships, but with regard to other countries on behalf of which freeboards are assigned by the Committee, the Committee must be guided by the decisions and interpretations of the Authorities in the respective countries.

The freeboards reports on the steamers "ALGERIA" and "MASILIA" are returned herewith.
