

S.S. "ALGERIA", "MASILIA" and "VALENCIA"

It is submitted Mr. Bulow be informed that it is observed that the Board of Directors have decided to retain the 1906 freeboards for these ships.

Amended assignment letters and certificates in accordance therewith should therefore be sent.

With regard to the third paragraph of his letter, Mr. Bulow should be informed that his statement to the Owners' representative that "the Society can only issue certificates in accordance with 1906 year's regulations or with the new Convention rules" is correct in so far as it applies to British ships, but with regard to other countries on behalf of which freeboards are assigned by the Committee, the Committee must be guided by the decisions and interpretations of the Authorities in the respective countries.
