Storhaver Engineering Ltd., Newhaven, Sussex, on 14th March, 1961 and subsequent dates for the purpose of examining and testing one 12 KW diesel generator set, previously used, and now intended for the vessel "Atlantic Dolphin" Messrs. J.S. Doig (Grimsby) Ltd. Yard No. 69.

The 3-cylinder 4 stroke diesel engine $4\frac{1}{2}$ " bore x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " stroke by R.A. Lister Ltd., No. 60/14559 was examined in its entirety and found or placed in good condition.

The DC Generator by Mawdsley, No. 80.S.15600, 220 volts 54.5 amps continuously rated 12KW at 1000 RPM. Enclosed ventilated, drip-proof, was also examined in its entirety megger tested and flash-tested and found or placed in good condition.

On completion the complete set which is arranged for Hand-starting and drives a compressor and general service pump through clutches was tested under full load working conditions and found in good order. In my opinion it is eligible to be classed by this Society and installed in the above named vessel.
