With reference to your letter of the 10th March, this ship is intended for special service and the equipment supplied is in accordance with Admiralty requirements. The Surveyor states that during trials he satisfied himself that the arrangements provided were efficient and adequate.

It is noted from your Telex message of the 11th March that the Rpt. C.11 has now been received.

The inner surface of bottom plating generally is covered with two coats of zinc chromate and one coat of white enamel, except in way of Engine and Boiler Room which has one coat of red lead and two coats of white enamel.
