has been surveyed at Kobe in May 1950

by the Surveyors to this Society, and reported to be in good, efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of 249 lb. per square inch on the main boilers. The approved working pressure of the donkey boiler is 8 lb. per square inch.

The survey having been completed, the Record LMC 5,50 (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register Book, subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules, & to the blading of HP and LP turbines being re-examined & dealt with as necessary by 5,51.


