The following alterations have now been carried out:-

Temporary gunner's accommodation in after 'tween decks removed. ✓

Starboard side: 3 sidelights removed and E.W. steel closing plates fitted. ✓

In tonnage well: Storm boards replaced in starboard side opening in forward bulkhead. ✓

Port side of tonnage well, 1 sidelight and one sanitary discharge removed and E.W. spigot closing plates fitted. ✓

1 port and 1 starboard small ventilators over tonnage well removed and E.W. spigot closing plates fitted.

Tonnage hatch on shelter deck: Steel closing plate together with companionway now removed and hatch coaming rest bars and wood covers restored to original condition. ✓
