We are in receipt of your memorandum of 11th July, initial "S", having reference to the inquiry contained in your Classing Letter of the 4th April last respecting our Report No. 1422.

In reply we have to confirm that the indents in bow and side shell plating and the slightly buckled wing plates of the bulkheads reported by us in March 1949 continue efficient and could be regarded as "endorsements" of class in accordance with Circular No. 1895.

We regret that your Classing Letter of the 4th April last escaped our attention.

We might add that the outstanding examination of the coal bunkers was dealt with before the vessel went into commission in April last. This information will appear in our report which will be forwarded in the near future.
