A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 2,64 but postponement until 7,64 has been recommended for approval after a satisfactory General Examination had been held and the Special Survey commenced at Jacksonville in 6,64.

ACTION is DEFERRED for completion of the S.S.

PORTION OF SURVEY HELD:-

INTERNAL EXAMINATION of:- Forward and after peak tanks,
Nos.1 & 2 port & starboard deep tanks,
Nos.1 & 4 D.B.tanks (p & s),
Cofferdam between Nos.3 & 4 D.B.tanks.

The KOBE Surveyors report (8,64), ship examined in dry dock and on account of damage due to various causes, keel, bottom and side shell plating (p & s) found to be extensively damaged. No repairs have been effected at this time and permanent repairs are recommended by completion of the Special Survey.

In a letter dated 29.8.64 the Kobe Surveyors state that in view of the extensive repairs recommended during the survey the Owners decided to defer completion of the Special Survey and requested that the ship be allowed to proceed to the U.K. for completion of the Special Survey or as it may be decided for scrapping. The Surveyors consider the ship in an efficient condition for the proposed voyage.

IT IS ~~FURTHER~~ SUBMITTED record of 'DS 8,64' be assigned, subject to set up and indented keel and bottom shell plating and side shell plating (p & s.f) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary also to the fore mast and main mast shrouds being renewed by completion of the S.S. but further ACTION be DEFERRED for completion of the S.S. *for repairs.*
