The above named vessel has recently been under survey at Mukaishima and it was the Owner's intention to complete the Special Survey at this time. (Due 3,64 and commenced at Tampa 5,64).


However, due to the great number of damages now found, and to the excessive repairs recommended at this time for the grounding damage, the Owners' decided to defer the survey and requested that the ship may proceed to the U.K. for the completion of SS or as it as may be decided for scrapping.

The ship held valid Load Line, Safety Equipment and Safety Radiotelegraphy Certificates and as the hull was in an efficient condition for the present it was agreed to recommend the Owner's request for consideration.

It is understood that the Owners' have not yet ordered new shrouds for the Fore and Main Masts (S.R.L. item) although these were condemned three months previously and has been further delayed until the future of the ship is decided.
