I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for General Examination for Postponement of Special Survey and Annual Load Line Survey.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

At this time vessel opened up and examined in accordance with requirements set forth in Circular No. 1959 for Postponement of Special Survey and found in satisfactory condition.

The following items examined now may, in my opinion, be credited towards Special Survey:

Internal Examination of Fore & After Peak Tank, No. 1 and No. 2 port & starboard Deep Tank, No. 1 Double Bottom Tank, No. 4 port & starboard Double Bottom Tank and Cofferdam between No. 3 & 4 Double Bottom Tank.

Owners' Representative stated that it is their intentions to drydock vessel on completion of discharge of cargo in Japan.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed ✓ without fresh record of dry docking, subject to conditions present attached to vessel's class being dealt with as previously recommended.
