I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 26th February, and in reply am pleased to inform you that in the circumstances the Committee will be prepared to maintain the vessel's class until she reaches Hong Kong for survey.

So far as the load line question is concerned, it will be necessary for a Load Line Survey to be held before a certificate is issued for the voyage from Japan to Hong Kong, and your local Agents should be asked to inform our Surveyors that their attendance is required in due course.

It is noted that you propose to hold the Special Survey in Hong Kong, and it is concluded you are not losing sight of the fact that according to the records here 150 fathoms of chain cable require to be renewed.
