We wish to confirm our verbal request through your Mr. R. Cook for an extension of class and Load Line Certificate for the above named vessel which is presently loading in Dutch New Guinea.

Due to the loading being delayed, the vessel cannot possibly discharge her cargo in Japan and return to Hongkong before the 10th. March to undergo her Special Survey.

We have already purchased most of the steel for renewals, and this is now in Hongkong awaiting the vessel's arrival therefore it would be most inconvenient and costly to have the survey carried out there.

Should the Committee see their way clear to grant the desired extension the vessel could be made available for a General Examination Afloat for a voyage from Japan to Hongkong.

It is presumed that the full requirements of a General Examination for one years extension would not be required at this time as it would entail preparation expenses both in Japan and again in Hongkong.
