## ANSWER

December 29, 1958.

This vessel came to Baltimore from Sweden on Date: board a freighter in Jan. 1957, when we made our first visit, two years ago. We attended her on the slipway, for installation of propelling machinery, other minor items and a short trial trip, but she remained here as we were informed the terminal piers at Nassau were not ready. In September 1958 she again came on the slipway and has remained here since. There are no Owner's Representatives in Baltimore and the only

information, which is meagre, that we get is from the Repairers who cannot explain the delay. Consequently I have written the Owners, the Paradise Beach & Transportation Co., Ltd. at Nassau; on receipt of their reply we will advise you further.
