The report of a survey of this vessel during construction has been received from the Surveyors at Stockholm, but assignment of the Class +A1 "Ferry service at Nassau Harbour" is being withheld pending completion of the Classification Survey.

It is understood that the ship is to be fitted out at Miami, and a copy of the Stockholm Surveyors' Rpts. 4b and 13 have been sent direct to that port for the Surveyor's guidance in this respect. It will also be necessary for sea trials to be held. When this had been done the Surveyor should report on the new First Entry Report Form, Rpt.4b.

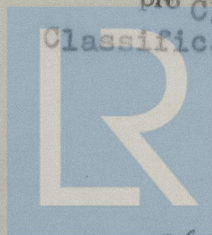
With regard to the hull, satisfactory steering trials remain to be carried out and a report furnished of the satisfactory condition of the Ferry on her arrival at Nassau.

I shall be glad if you will arrange for these matters to receive attention. The Surveyors' reports are awaited in due course.
