REDUCED RATE TELEGRAMS

One of the following indicators, which count as one word, must be inserted before the address and included in the number of words to be paid for.

- ELT EUROPEAN LETTER TELEGRAM.**—To most European countries. Half ordinary rate. Plain language only. The minimum charge is for 22 words. Delivery is subject to a delay of at least 5 hours from the time of handing in.
- LT LETTER TELEGRAM.**—To most other countries. Half ordinary rate. Plain language only. The minimum charge is for 22 words. Delivery is usually the day following the day of handing in.
- GLT COMMONWEALTH SOCIAL TELEGRAM.**—To countries of the British Commonwealth. Messages of a social character, greetings, family news or non-commercial personal affairs. Plain language only. The charge is 9s. 2d. for 11 words except to Canada 7s. 1d., West Indies 7s. 1d., Cyprus 7s. 6d. Delivery is usually the day following the day of handing in.

CONDITIONS

1.—Either the Postmaster General or any Telegraph Company or Government, by whom this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded, may decline to forward the telegram although it has been received for that purpose; but in such case the amount paid for transmission shall be refunded to the sender at his request.

2.—Neither the Postmaster General nor any officer of the Post Office nor any Telegraph Company or Government, by whom this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded, nor any of the servants or officers of such Telegraph Company or Government, shall be liable to make compensation for any loss, injury, or damage arising or resulting from non-transmission or non-delivery of the telegram, or delay, or error, or omission in the transmission or delivery thereof, through whatever cause such non-transmission, non-delivery, delay, error, or omission shall have occurred.

3.—This telegram shall be forwarded in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations with reference to Overseas Telegrams made pursuant to the Telegraph Acts, and the provisions of such Regulations shall be deemed to be binding not only between the sender and the Postmaster General, but between the sender and any Telegraph Company or Government by whom this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded.
