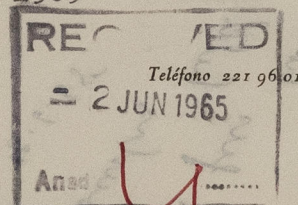

Dear Sir,

M.T. "CAMPERO"

The above vessel has been under survey at this port for Special Survey of Hull and Machinery etc.

As regards the machinery there is some doubt as to whether or not this comes under the Continuous Survey type of inspection.

The Owners Supt. contends that most of their older vessels do not have continuous survey of machinery, including "CAMPERO".

However, in the S.R.L. Appendix is noted "CS Meh" but in the Supplements there is no prefix "CS" although other vessels of the same Company have the prefix "CS".

I have been in touch with Madrid Office and it is stated there is no record of the Owners having applied for C.S. there.

When the vessel came under survey in October last I wrote to Head Office for outstanding items to complete the Continuous Survey and this list was supplied.

However all the machinery has been examined at this time and the complete Special Survey requirements carried out except for the electrical survey.

The Owners Supt. stated that approx 5 years ago all the machinery special survey requirements were carried out in one lengthy lay up when the vessel was reclassified.

The main point at issue is the fee to be charged.

If the vessel has not continuous survey the fee will be Ptas. 39.860. If the vessel has continuous survey the total fee will be 79.720 Ptas.

I shall be glad to have your comments on the above as quickly as possible in order that our report may be completed.
