E. I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant enclosing one from the St. Etienne Surveyor respecting the air receivers made by Messrs. Brunon & Valette for the m.s. "CAMPERO", and note the remarks contained therein.

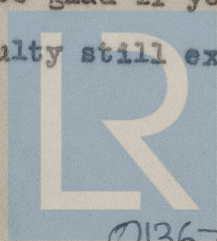
In the circumstances the air receivers will be accepted in this instance, provided the thickness be in accordance with the Rules.

I shall be glad, however, if you will ascertain from the St. Etienne Surveyor the internal diameter of each size of air receiver covered by his report, forwarded with your letter.

In connexion with this matter, it may be observed that the French Navy Specification mentioned by you was accepted at the special request of Messrs. Sulzer Bros., in view of their statement that the only French Firm from whom they were able to secure a tender for the manufacture of air receivers had informed them that they were unable to accept any specification other than that of the French Navy.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly let me know whether the same difficulty still exists, or whether
