submitted to bend tests only.-

*Plan No 2300*  
On the 4 receivers of the plan C.U No 2300, the  
same has been done.-

All these materials were from the same charge.-

In regard to the internal diameter of each receiver,  
same is in accordance with the plans C.U. No 2299 and  
C.U. No 2300, with allowances + or - permitted.-

Enclosed please find two tables of the thicknesses  
before "Ogivage" (upsetting (?)) of the four receivers of  
each of those plans.-

The receivers were seamless drawn, the internal  
and external sizes being in accordance with the above stated  
plans (Allowances + or - permitted)
