I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for General Examination on arrival in its service area and damage stated due to contact with the "UNITED FOUR" whilst at anchorage at Colombo at 14.30 hours on 3rd December, 1963, during towing passage from Karachi to Chittagong.

For further particulars see Log Book of tow ship M. S. "MAQBOOLBAKSH".

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

NOW DONE:- Barge examined afloat and the following damages found and permanent repairs effected.

Starboard side: Aft section of bulwark plates 8' long buckled, one stay buckled and bulwark cap bar buckled and twisted over 8' - Removed, faired and replaced. Deck in way of the above buckled - Faired in position.

Portside: Forward 6' bulwark plate buckled; 2 bulwark stays twisted; approximately 15' cap bar buckled - Removed, faired and replaced. One stem bar rivet and 4 rivets in 1st frame starboard side leaking - Renewed.

Portside: 11 Guard rail stanchion feet missing - Renewed; 5 stanchion feet buckled - Faired in position.

Starboard side: 5 Guard rail stanchion feet missing - Renewed; six stanchion feet buckled - Faired in position.

I recommend that this ship ~~be~~ ~~remain~~ ~~classified~~ ~~with/without fresh record of dry docking~~ as contemplated

4 Guard rail wires broken - Renewed.


One Rudder coupling bolt missing - Renewed; remaining rudder coupling nuts slackened back - Hardened up.

Portside ventilator between No. 1 and No.2 hatchways pushed through deck - Ventilator removed, indented deck plate cropped and part renewed and ventilator replaced.

Portside: deck in way of after bollard - Faired in position.

On completion of the above damage repairs Barge was generally examined and found in good condition. Freeboard Marks verified and found in accordance with the Load Line Certificate.

It is recommended that the Barge be classed as contemplated.
