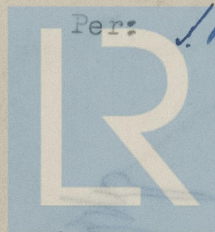
With reference to your Classing Letter of the 27th ultimo regarding the "YEOMAN" we beg to state that it is considered that a further 15 fathoms of chain cable should be supplied as in the case of the sister ship "BOWMAN", (Hul. Rpt. 60445), please see Classing Letter of the 17th August.

With reference to your further enquiries the Boiler room is coated with bitumastic enamel, the remaining spaces being cemented, and we confirm that the vessel was built in 1944 by Messrs. Richard Dunston, Ltd., her previous name being "T.I.D. 90".
