I duly received your letter of the 16th October regarding the enquiry received by you from Mr. P.E. Caton, a prospective purchaser of the above ship. I should explain that ships of the "CHANT" type were not intended for long sea voyages, and are not suitable for voyages between the Azores and the European Ports mentioned.

We have had correspondence with the Owners, through Mr. Sims at Havre, concerning the service limits of this ship, and I enclose for your information a copy of my letter of to-day's date exchanging telegrams with him.

The undersigned will discuss this case with you in Paris next week, and will inform you then of the re-classification fees involved.
