I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th April and note your comments.

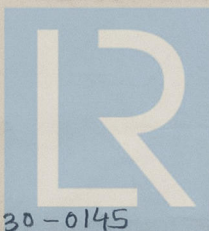
It is considered it might be helpful if you were once more to write to the Far East Enterprising Co. (H.K.) Ltd., and point out that if the present Owners request withdrawal from class while no surveys are overdue, it is likely that the Committee will mark the vessel "Class withdrawn at Owners' request", whereas if the Owners do not make such an application the Committee will probably feel they have no alternative but to withdraw the class owing to non-compliance with the Regulations once a survey has fallen due.

For your own information I would remark that the next survey which is reckoned to fall due is a Docking Survey which should be held before February 1963 and if no reply is received from the Owners to the present proposed communication, the case will not be brought to the Committee until early next year.
