

These two ships were built under the Society's classification 1946. They were transferred from the "Ghost Book" into the register book in 1947-48 and 1948-49 respectively, and remained til the 1954-55 edition when all particulars were omitted in cordance with Committee Minute dated 15th January, 1954.

They have now been purchased by Messrs. F.T. Everard & Sons, l., and are under survey at Hull for conversion to tankers and classification with the Society.
