With reference to Liverpool First Entry Report No. 119767 on the steamer "C.614", I have to inform you the Committee have today assigned a class of "100A1" with notations of "Cargo Battens Not Fitted", "Lloyd's A-& CP", "LMC 7,43 & OG".

It is concluded Bulb angle frames have been fitted from frame 59 forward as indicated on the approved plan of profile and decks, but confirmation on this point is desired and it is considered the Surveyors should be referred to Circular No. 1551 and informed it is concluded the length of the poop for record purposes is 49 ft. as shown on the sketch of their freeboard report, and not as stated in their First Entry Report.
